We were able to increase our knowledge of Tibetan pharmacopoeia and discover the secrets of this ancient wisdom through our local partner, Karpo, **founder of the Dzongsar health clinic** and manufacturer of traditional medicines.

A new, ultra modern 5000 m² laboratory has been built in a grandiose setting at over 3700 meters altitude.

The objective of this laboratory, which champions traditional Tibetan medicine, is to comply with international pharmaceutical standards, in order to showcase and promote this medicine worldwide.
